Annual Sports Competition 2024



Cyber security is the practice of protecting systems, networks, and data from digital attacks, theft, and damage. It encompasses various technologies, processes, and practices designed to secure devices, sensitive information, and infrastructure from cyber threats. Here are the key aspects of cyber security-

1. Importance of Cyber security Prevents data breaches and identity theft.
O Secures sensitive information from hackers.
O Ensures business continuity by preventing cyber-attacks.
O Protects individuals, businesses, and governments from financial losses.
2. Types of Cyber Threats
O Malware: Malicious software like viruses, ransomware, spyware, and worms.
O Phishing: Deceptive emails or messages that trick users into providing sensitive information.
O Denial-of-Service (DoS) Attacks: Overloading a system to disrupt services.
O Man-in-the-Middle (MitM) Attacks: Intercepting communication to steal or manipulate data
O Zero-Day Exploits: Attacking vulnerabilities in software before they are fixed.
O Social Engineering: Manipulating people to gain unauthorized access to systems or data.

O Regular Software Updates: Patches security vulnerabilities.
O Security Awareness Training: Educates users about cyber threats and safe practices.
