Competent Authority: In accordance with the Maharashtra Government Extraordinary Notification No.232 published on 05/07/2018, Government of Maharashtra vide Government Resolution Higher and Technical Education Department No. Sankirn-2019/(C.R.06/19)TE-5 dated 06/02/2019, **Director, Technical Education** is the Competent Authority for implementation of all the activities related to admission of Diploma Courses under the purview of Directorate of Technical Education, Maharashtra State.

- CAP Allotment,
- Self-verification of allotment before seat acceptance,

- Reporting to Institutes by candidates for admissions to First Year Diploma in Engineering

Eligibility Criteria for Admission:

- **Maharashtra State/ Jammu & Kashmir & Ladakh Migrant/ All India Candidates**
 - The Candidate should be an Indian National.
 - Passed 10th Std./ SSC examination or its equivalent, with at least 35% aggregate marks.

(Note: Other than Maharashtra State Candidates shall be eligible for Institution quota only as All India Candidates.)

10. Rules & Regulations

1. Student while studying in the Institute, if found indulging in anti-national activities contrary to the provision of acts and laws enforced by government, will be expired from the Institute without any notice by the Principal of Institute.
2. Candidates applying for admission against the seats reserved or backward classes should note that only those candidates who actually belong to the castes and communities will be eligible for the admission.
3. If any of the statements made in the application form or any information supplied by the candidate in connection with his/her admission is at any time found to be false or incorrect, such candidate will not be considered for admission and if already admitted, his/her admission will be cancelled, fees forfeited and he/she may be prosecuted by

government, if deemed necessary. An appeal against the order of expulsion however may be preferred within 8 days from the date of expulsion with the director of technical education whose decision in such cases will be final and binding.

4. The candidate on admission, shall be governed by general rules and also by the disciplinary rules prescribed by the Institute for the students.
5. Mobiles are strictly prohibited inside the Institute campus.

- **Rules and conduct of examination as prescribed by MSBTE**

This Institute is affiliated to Maharashtra State board of technical education, Mumbai. The candidates taking admission to first year will have to enroll their names with Maharashtra State board of technical education, Mumbai (MSBTE). The enrollment forms will be filled at the Institute in September. The admission to the course will stand automatically cancelled if the enrollment form is not filled. Candidates who have passed their X std. (SSC) from a board outside the Maharashtra state (ICSE/CBSE., Gujarat, J & K) will have to obtain the eligibility certificate from the MSBTE. Confirmation of admission will be based on ground of eligibility by the MSBTE.

For getting admission to the higher year the candidates must pass through minimum 2/3 of total subjects as prescribed by MSBTE. Candidates obtaining ATKT result will be promoted to the higher year. However no candidate will be promoted to 3rd year unless he has completely passed the first year examination.

- **General rules for students:**

1. Student should be regular and punctual in attending classes, tutorials and submissions of the term-work in various subjects, terms shall not be granted and student shall not be certified for examination if his progress, conduct and attendance is not as per rules laid down by MSBTE.
2. Students, if found to indulge in antinational activities contrary to the provisions of the acts and laws enforced by government, will be liable to be expelled from the college without any notice by the Principal of the college.
3. Ragging of students in any form within or outside of the college and hostel is strictly prohibited. Defaulters will be strictly dealt with as per Government of Maharashtra instructions in this matter.

4. Smoking, drinking (alcohol) and use of 'drugs' is strictly prohibited within or outside the premises of the college and hostel.
5. Bicycles, scooters and vehicles should be parked only in areas provided for the purpose. The Institute accepts no responsibility for their safe custody. Vehicles parked elsewhere maybe confiscated.
6. Any changes in the address of the student must be intimated by him in writing to the college office immediately.
7. A student must carry identity card signed by the Principal and produce the same whenever asked by the college authorities. Without identity card, students will not be allowed to enter the college premises and will be strictly dealt with.
8. A student is expected to read the notices put up on the notice board of the college the College accepts no responsibility for loss of any advantage by student due to his failure to read the notice in time.
9. In case, a student requires to remain absent for some reasons, he/ she will be required to take the prior permission of the Principal.
10. If any of the statement made in application form any information supplied by the student in connection with his/her admission is later on, at any time found to be false or incorrect, his/her admission will be cancelled, fees forfeited and he/she be expelled from the college by the Principal and prosecuted by government if deemed necessary.
11. A student shall not go to the press or any other publicity media without permission of the Principal, for any reason, connected or remote, concerning Institute.
12. Compensation of any damage to the college property apparatus, furniture, equipment, library books, building etc. must be paid immediately by the student.
13. Student must attend social and national event organised by the college such as 26th January, 10th may and 15th August, Annual social gathering and all other declared National celebrations.
14. A student will be bound by the rules and regulations framed by the college from time to time.
15. No student will be allowed to appear for the board examination unless he/she has paid all his/her dues and completed his/her journals and has attendance as per rules laid down by MSBTE.
